

# LONGBOARD

*Vineyards*

*The components were harvested at an average of 24.6 ° brix (mature but still possessing good acid), fermented and allowed to rest on the skins for an additional period in order to get good extraction of color and tannins. They were then drawn into French oak barrels for 23 months of ageing and bottled unfinned and unfiltered.*

**Composition:**

92% Cabernet Sauvignon  
6% Malbec, 2% Merlot

**Appellation:** Sonoma County

**Ageing:** 23 months in French Oak barrels, 30% New

**Analysis:** Alcohol 14.5 %  
TA 5.85 g/L pH 3.72

**Production:** 223 Cases

Drink it over the next 10-15 years.*
