

The longer I make wines - the more simplistic my views get. In this case, I have to force myself to write about this wine because all I want to say is: "Classic Pinot Noir" It is as if anything else I write about it will just take away from a wine that speaks for itself.

This wine comes from a Russian River Valley hillside vineyard we call "Mystos" because its owners do not want their name in print. Mystos is also the name of a surf spot known only to the locals who surf the Sonoma Coast. Sorry, we can't tell you where it is....

In a time when many producers go after a big, juicy style of this variety, what we call a "Crowd Please Pinot" I choose to pull the reins just a tad, allowing the varietal character to show by not letting overly bold flavors dominate it. To me, this is the equivalent of eating a good steak with only salt and pepper rather than smothering it with "A1" sauce. Nothing wrong with that approach, just not my style.

This Pinot Noir is one that makes you think of great friendships - quiet, constantly evolving and complex; it makes you stop and look deep inside yourself. Yes, it is only a wine, but the vintage, the location, the resident-yeast fermentation and the delicate oak selected for long maturation - all worked in unison to produce a uniquely balanced wine with great acidity that begs you to design a perfect meal around it. It will age well, like good friendships tend to do.
